

MPS 2010 Camp Regulations

As a student who is a good leader in your high school band, there is no need to stress the importance of good conduct. However, there are a few guidelines that must be followed:

1. All student leaders are never late. Plan to be five minutes early to each session.
2. If you feel ill at any time and are unable to attend a scheduled session, please contact an MPS staff member immediately.
3. Name tags must be worn at all times.
4. Be sure to bring your backpack with three-ring binder, pens or pencils, and other necessary equipment to all sessions. Each student will need to purchase a copy of the following books at the Seminar: *A Percussionist's Guide to Check Patterns* and the *Championship Concepts for Marching Percussion Student Workbook*. If you enrolled in the Section Leader Track, you will be required to purchase *Championship Concepts for Marching Percussion* main textbook as well. Bring all three of these books to camp with you if you already own them. You will use these texts throughout the week for reference, reading, and practice assignments.
5. Students are not permitted to leave campus at any time. If you drive to campus, your automobile is to be parked, locked, and will remain off-limits throughout the seminar. You must leave your keys with the designated staff member on the first night of the Seminar.
6. Visitation by persons who are not enrolled in the Seminar is not permitted.
7. Please keep your room locked at ALL times. Do not leave any money or other valuables anywhere on campus. The Mobile Percussion Seminar and the University of Massachusetts cannot be held responsible for loss of personal property.
8. Absolutely NO smoking, alcohol or illegal substances will be used, possessed, or exhibited by anyone during the seminar. You may not, under any circumstances, visit the rooms or floors housing members of the opposite sex.
9. Room checks will be held each evening before "Lights Out" to ensure all students are accounted for. After room checks have been completed, you must remain in your room for the remainder of the night.
10. Plan to eat all meals that are provided – especially breakfast! You will need your energy.

11. Please leave your room in the same condition at the close of the Seminar as when you moved in and return your key. Each student will be charged \$60 for any key not returned. You will also be held financially responsible for any cleaning or repairs that need to take place as a result of your stay.

Failure to comply with these or any other regulations established by the Mobile Percussion Seminar will result in immediate dismissal from the seminar WITHOUT a refund of fees/tuition. Your parents will be responsible for immediate transportation home.
